What modifications do you suggest for the next time the course is taught?


Comments

Phrasing on questions for the homework and exams were a bit confusing. Maybe improving on that would make things easier to understand.



I'm not sure, since this was a summer class everything was very quick. I think it was organized well in the short amount of time.






My overall rating of the teaching - Vs. GPA




My overall rating of this course Vs. GPA




The amount of effort you put into the course Vs. My overall rating of the teaching




The amount of effort you put into the course Vs. My overall rating of this course
