






Gap Analysis- Department VS. Course







Maybe I'm just slow, but it would be helpful to have the content cut down a little bit, it was too much cramped in one semester More real world examples






My overall rating of the teaching - Vs. GPA




My overall rating of this course Vs. GPA




The amount of effort you put into the course Vs. My overall rating of the teaching




