





### The amount of effort you put into the course




## The number of times you were absent from class

#### Comments

Honestly I have no suggestions. He structured the class really well.


Everything you did was fine, I just wish more of the students in the class participated.

No modifications come to my head, to be honest, it was a very well structured course overall, and the teacher was really good! The policies helped me understand more on what my focus should be.


No regressions or ecnomterics we did the basics of it I feel but it was definelty a lot to take in since ive never took either of those courses.

I felt like I didn't really need to read the assigned books to write the papers.






## My overall rating of the teaching - Vs. GPA




## My overall rating of this course Vs. GPA




## The amount of effort you put into the course Vs. My overall rating of the teaching


